

Procedures to View IP Cameras via Mobile Phone

It only requires 3 steps to view real-time streaming of IP cameras via mobile phone.

Step 1、 Camera Settings

Similar to PCs, the camera must be connected to the Internet.

The IP camera should be able to connect to the Internet and do the necessary configurations automatically.

If it fails, user is required to run Setup software on a PC and click on “Network” to configure the IP camera. System requires “port-mapping” for RTP and RTSP on user’s router. The RTSP, RTP, RTCP within the system settings must be set.

The port range for above is from 7002 to 7998., RTCP port = RTP port + 1.

Step 2、 Account Registration

Camera may register a name, as a substitute for an IP address, for the convenience of user.

Both mobile phone view and PC view use the SAME account name. Cameras will deliver different streams to support PCs and mobile phone users.

Open IE with URL: <http://pc.easyipcam.com> for registration, click “New user register” to enter the registration interface. (more details available from the SETUP manual)

Step 3、 Mobile phone settings

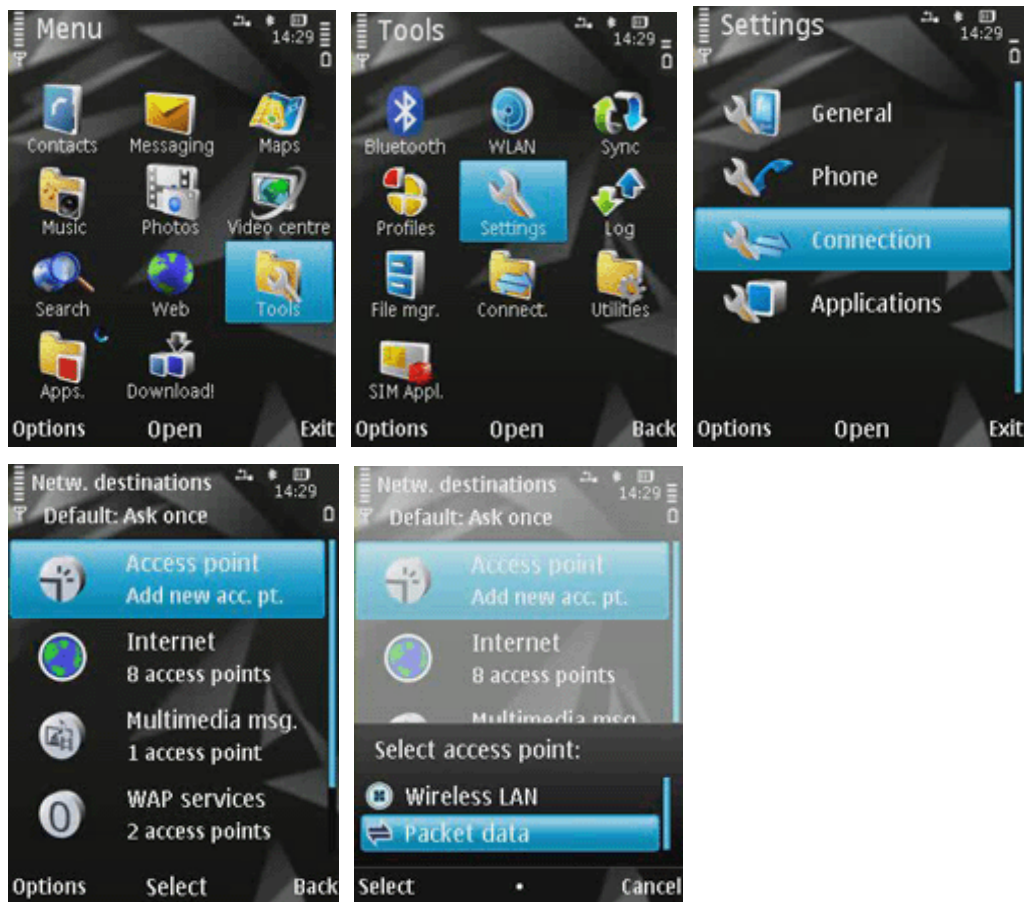
For mobile phones to view IP camera, it requires a player software and one of the following internet connections:

- Wi-fi
- GPRS, CDMA, EDGE
- 3G (WCDMA, TD-SCDMA, CDMA2000), 4G (LTE...), etc...

Ex 1: Symbian (with RealPlayer)

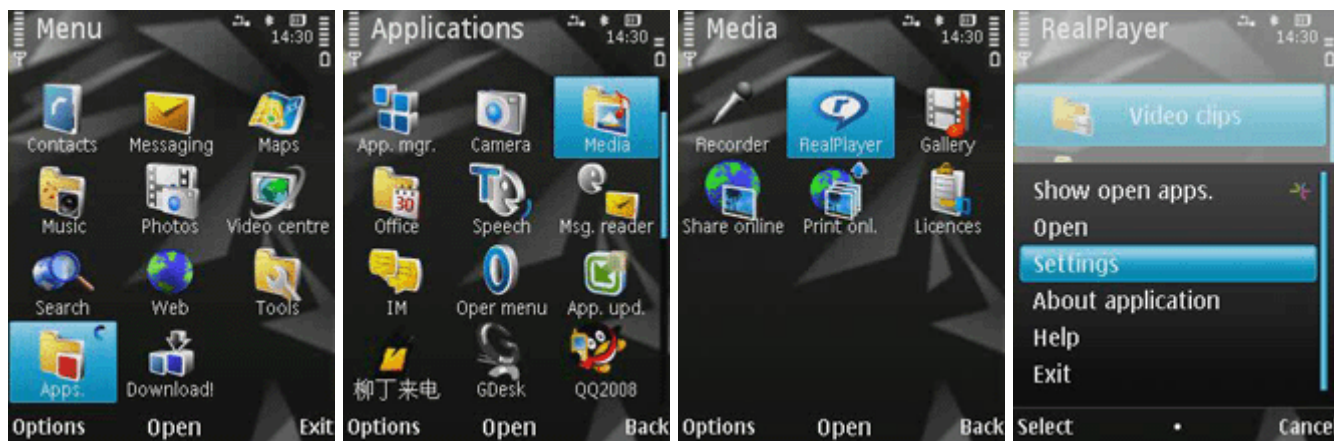
Step 1: Add Access Point

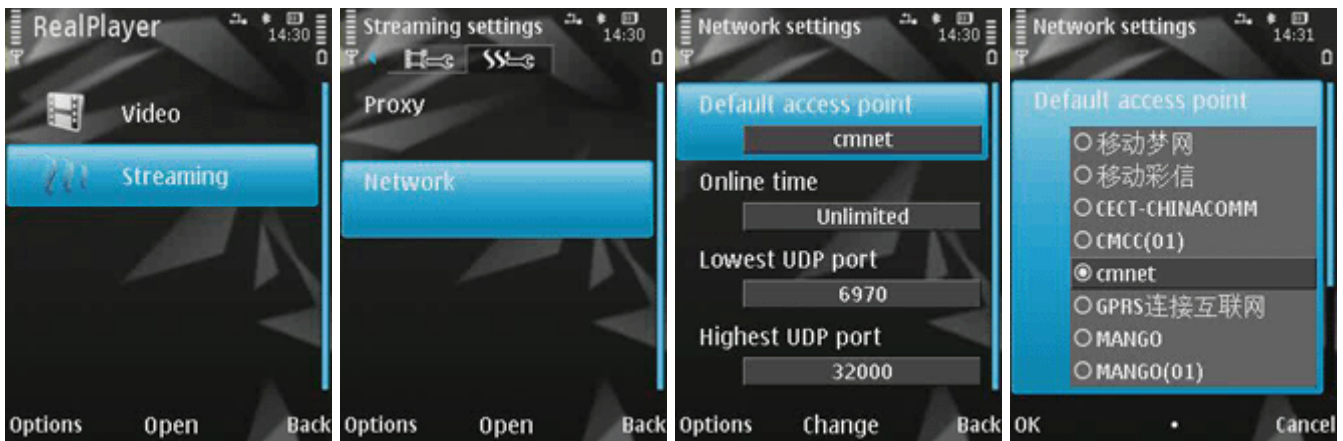
Menu→Tools→Settings→Connection→Access points



Step 2: Set the streaming's default access point of RealPlayer to CMNET (China Mobile)

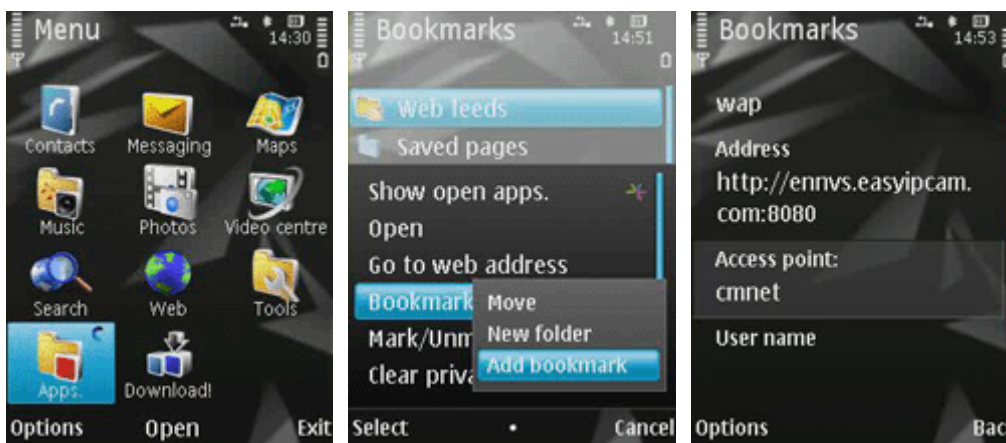
Menu→Applications→Media→RealPlayer→Options→Settings→Streaming→Network→Default access point→CMNET





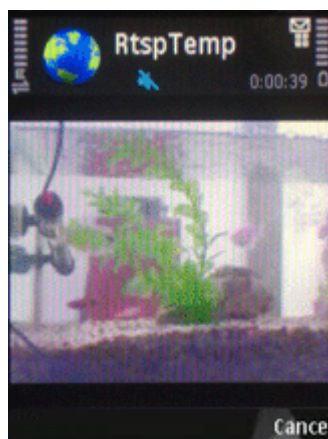
Step 3: Web Settings

Menu→Web→Bookmarks→Options→Bookmark manager→Add bookmark
 →Enter name, address([http:// http://wap.easyipcam.com](http://wap.easyipcam.com), Account ID: , Password:),
 then select access point as CMNET.



Step 4: Mobile phone live view

Select the new bookmark wap to open the login page. Enter account name, password, and then click "login". The user's camera list shall appear, select camera and click "view" to watch.



Ex 2: iphone (version 3.0 or later)

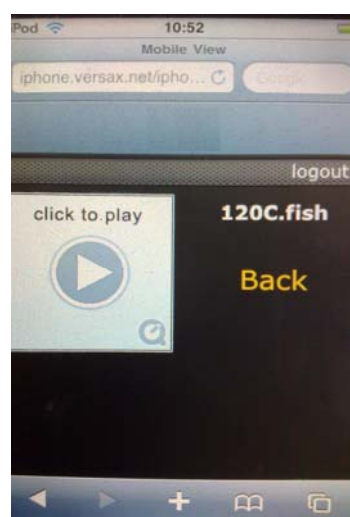
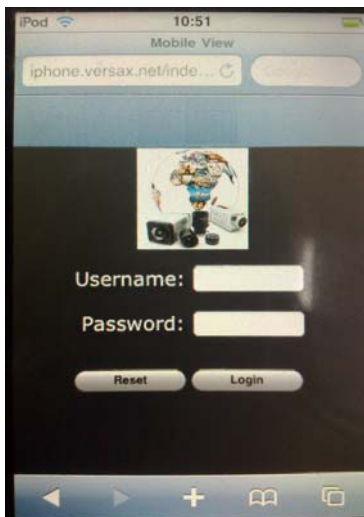
Step 1: Active 3G (WCDMA, TD-CDMA, CDMA2000...etc) or Wi-fi for your iphone.

Step 2: Run Safari

Step 3: Keyin URL:http://iphone.easyipcam.com

Step 4: Login the username and password

Step 5: Select the camera name to view its real-time video stream.



Ex 3: Windows Mobile (version 5.0 or later)

For Mobile Phones that utilize Windows Mobile 6.0 O.S, it requires the installation of a third-party player. (for ex: CorePlayer).

Step 1: Setup the network connection. Please contact your local ISP for details.

After adding the access point, return to “Network Management” and to locate the new access point.

Step 2: Install a third-party player (the following is the installation steps for CorePlayer)

Install CorePlayer.v1.2.5. and remember its installation path.

Step 3: Patching

After installation, login to <http://wap.easyipcam.com> , download rtsppatch.coreplayer.v1.2.5..cab installation packet. The packet will install automatically after download, set the installation path same as the CorePlayer.v.1.2.5.

Step 4: Mobile Phone View

Open the browser after finishing the above steps. Login <http://wap.easyipcam.com> to enter the mobile phone view login page.
